Submission guidelines:

Submitted papers shall be related to the scope and listed topics of this conference.

Submitted papers should not have been previously published or presented in any form.

Abstracts of submitted papers must include titles, research backgrounds, research methods, and 3 to 5 keywords. The word count should not exceed 250 Chinese characters, or 300 English words.

Each participant can only present one paper. If a participant has more than one abstract accepted, they must choose one and inform the organizer when registering and paying the fee.

Participants must submit abstracts through the provided link; the conference organiser does not accept other forms of submission.

The deadline for abstract submission is 23:59 (AEST) on May 1st, 2024.

The results of abstract selection will be notified by email on May 31st, 2024.

All participants presenting papers must register and pay the conference fee by the required date to confirm their participation.
